







### Information For Students on Key Dates for Jan 2026 intake

- 1. All N(A)\*/N(T) school leavers are encouraged to submit an application during the 1<sup>st</sup> Phase (Main Phase) between Thursday, 18 December 2025 (2.30 pm) to Monday, 22 December 2025 (5.00 pm). Application results for the 1<sup>st</sup> Phase will be released on Friday, 26 December 2025 from 9.00 am
- 2. If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered <u>before</u> applying in the **2**<sup>nd</sup> Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase) between <u>Friday, 26 December 2025 to Friday, 2 January 2026</u>. The application results for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase will be known on <u>Tuesday, 6 January 2026 from 9.00 am</u>.
- 3. Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase (Final Top-up Phase) between Friday, 9 January 2026 and Friday, 16 January 2026 and Thursday, 22 January to Friday 6 February 2026 for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase will be known between Monday, 12 January and Thursday, 22 January 2026 and Thursday, 22 January and Wednesday, 11 February 2026.

- N(A) students with an ELMAB3 score of 16 to 19 who wish to apply for Sec 5 N(A) in 2026 are required to book an appointment with an ECG counsellor on Friday, 19 December 2025, between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm. Bookings should be made today, Thursday, 18 December 2025, after 2.30 pm.
- All students must participate in the application process, which closes on Monday, 22 December 2025 at 5.00 pm.

# Release of ITE Posting Results and Acceptance of ITE Offers

- The ITE posting results will be released on **Friday, 26 December 2026 at 9.00 am**. Students may check the posting results online via the ITE application portal.
- Students who receive ITE offer should accept the offer via the ITE application portal between Friday, 26 December 2025 (9.00 am) and Friday, 2 January 2026 (11.59 am).
- Students who wish to appeal should also accept the given ITE offer before making an appeal.

### Application for the Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) for N(A) students (JIE 'H' Exercise) 2-year Higher Nitec

2-year Higher Nitec Courses

- Students who are eligible for the Direct Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)
   (ELMAB3 score of 19 or below) will participate in the JIE 'H' Exercise, which provides direct entry
   into full-time 2-year Higher Nitec courses.
- N(A) students who are eligible for the JIE 'H' Exercise should also apply for the JIE 'N' Exercise.
- Applications for the DPP can be submitted online via the ITE application portal (<a href="https://www.ite.edu.sg">https://www.ite.edu.sg</a>) between 2.30 pm on Thursday, 18 December 2025 and 5.00 pm on Monday, 22 December 2025.

Note: Students who have obtained an EMB3 score of 16 to 19 and are interested in applying for Sec 5 N(A) in 2026 must make an appointment on Thursday, 18 December 2025 (after 2.30 pm) to meet the school's ECG Counsellor Ms Juan on Friday, 19 December 2025.

## Application for the Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) for N(A) students

- Applications for the Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) will open in January 2026,
  on the day the GCE O-Level Examination results are released. Eligible candidates will
  receive a copy of Form P on the same day, inviting them to submit their applications.
- Students who are interested in applying for the PFP should report to Secondary 5 Normal (Academic) on Friday, 2 January 2026 while awaiting notification of their eligibility and confirmation of a place in the PFP programme.
- Students who are interested in both the PFP and the Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) should apply for the two-year Higher Nitec course under the DPP. They may withdraw from the Higher Nitec course after receiving their PFP application results.
- Students who are eligible for the PFP are required to continue attending their Secondary 5 Normal (Academic) classes or Higher Nitec (DPP) courses until the last Friday of January 2026, which is 30 January 2026.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

You should receive the following from your CCs:

- Result Slip
- Examination Certificate
- Form N (4NA and 4NT)
- CCA Certificate
- Testimonial (Draft)

You should acknowledge on the class list the receipt of items 1-5.



### **Amendment Process – CCA Certificates**

Actions to take for any amendment to the CCA Certificate:

- STILL <u>acknowledge the RECEIPT</u>
- Clearly <u>indicate the error</u> and bring the <u>edited copy</u> to the <u>General Office</u> after release of results (4.00 pm onwards)
- GO staff will attend to you
- Ask for a <u>duplicate copy / copies</u> to facilitate your applications before you leave the GO



### **Amendment Process – N Level Certificates**

Candidates may request for a re-print of their certificate only if their name has been printed wrongly due to misspelling. Other reasons for re-printing of certificates will not be accepted.

There is an administrative fee of **\$\$50.00** (inclusive of GST) for the amendment of each GCE N-Level certificate.

Please indicate the error and bring the edited copy to the General Office after the release of results (4.00 pm onwards) and GO staff will attend to you.



### **Appeal for Review of Results**

- Candidates of 2025 GCE N(A)/N(T)-Level examination may apply to appeal for a review of results.
- All appeals by candidates must be submitted through schools.
- Candidates can request for an 'Individual Appeal'.
- The candidate will be informed of the outcome via a letter.
- No report on the candidate's performance will be provided.
- The payment for an individual appeal is \$125.00 per subject. Candidates shall pay the appeal fees via the SEAB Candidates Portal by Friday, 26 December 2025, 12.00 pm.
- Applications submitted after the closing date will not be considered.
